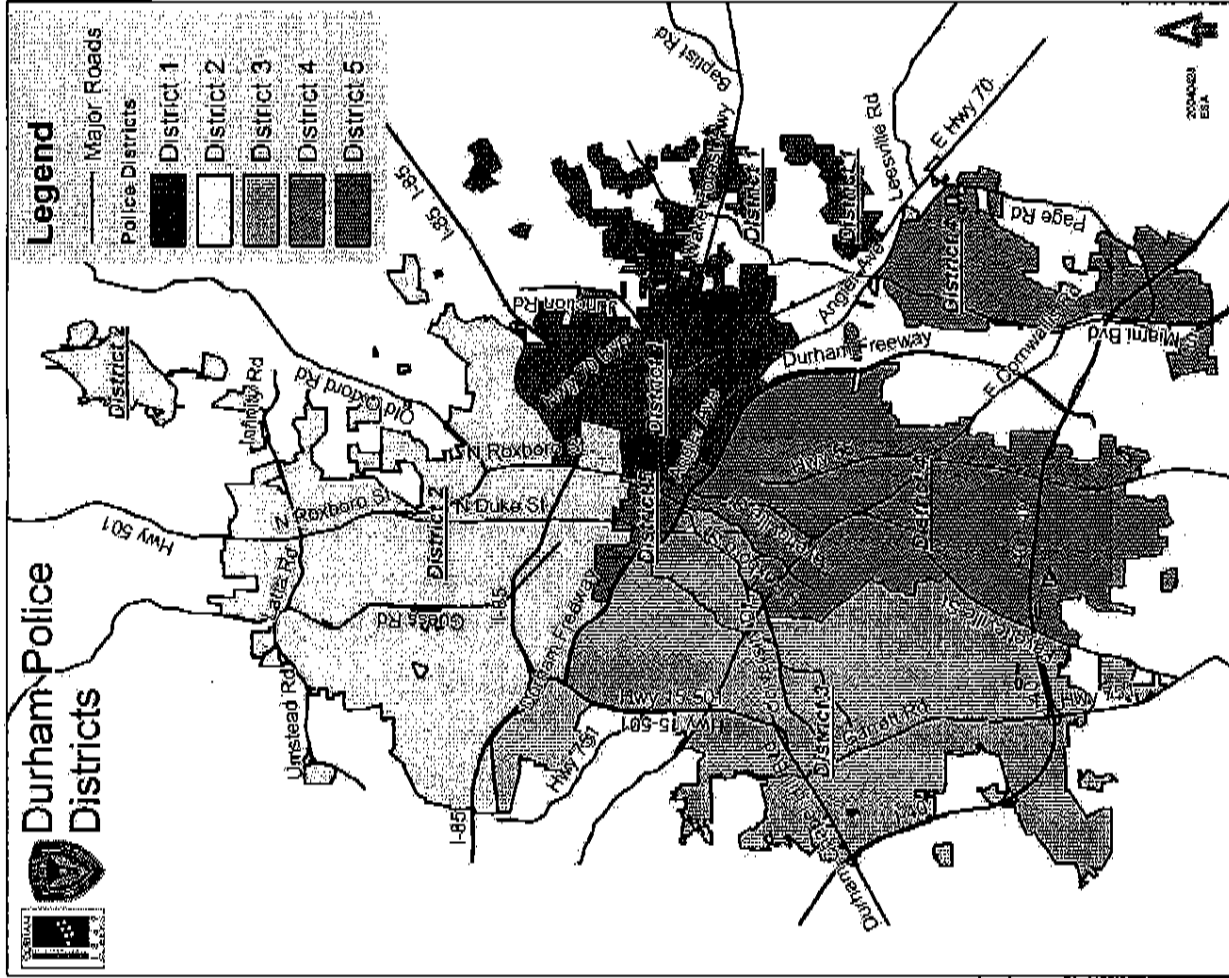


Which police district do I live in?



What is PAC?

PAC stands for Partners Against Crime, where Durham citizens work with city and county officials to prevent crime and other problems in our neighborhoods. Meetings are regularly attended by representatives from the Police, Housing, Community Development, Parks and Rec, Solid Waste, Public Works, and Finance departments. There is a PAC group for each of Durham's five police districts, and a Durham Businesses Against Crime (DBAC) group for local businesses.

What does PAC do?

We work together to identify and resolve problems in neighborhoods, including:

- abandoned vehicles
- weedy lots
- waste cleanup
- barking dogs
- drug houses
- unsafe buildings

How does it work?

Each PAC group communicates every day, using an email list. Breaking news about crime and crime prevention is shared in these email messages. Each PAC group also has a monthly meeting with police representatives.
